Walk for Healing, Walk for Hope Help Us Build a Basic Health Clinic for the Nsobe Community in Rural Zambia

As Nsobe School continues to grow, so too does the need for accessible, basic healthcare. Currently, the nearest medical care is far away, a very long walk, and often inaccessible in emergencies. Too many children miss school due to treatable illnesses. Too many families face preventable suffering because basic health services are out of reach.



With your help, we aim to raise funds for a fully functional rural health post equipped with basic medical supplies, trained health personnel, and a strong referral link to nearby hospitals. We are applying to the Welsh Government for funding to build a **rural health clinic**, but their generous contribution will only cover part of the cost. A simple onsite clinic will:

- Provide immediate treatment for malaria, infections, and minor injuries
- Support mothers with pre and post natal care
- Provide Under-5 Clinics for immunisations, growth monitoring, and early treatment for childhood illnesses, giving every child a healthier start in life during their most vulnerable years, and guiding mothers in childhood care
- Be staffed and supplied by the Zambian Ministry of Health—but only **if we build it**
