
## Join our 10-mile Gower Yomp and raise vital funds for Nsobe Community School in rural Zambia.

Nsobe Community School was founded by Fiona
Tomlinson in 2009 and has grown from 16 children in a small room in Fiona's house to a school of 530 pupils and 27 teachers from pre-school to Grade 12 (GCSE level). The foundation of Nsobe Community School is local staff who understand the challenges families face such as poverty, unemployment and malnutrition. Strong ties with

the children's families allow us to challenge cultural prejudices especially towards girls and encourage lasting positive change.
